

HOST a MOOCHIE KALALA SCIENCE EVENT at your SCHOOL!

New science exploration TV show 'Moochie Kalala Detectives Club' will be hosting events at local Chicagoland schools during April and May! Events will engage students in science with an Assembly-Style event that features an episode screening, plus related interactive science demonstration and Q&A from one of our Museum partners including Shedd Aquarium, Adler Planetarium, Museum of Science and Industry, Frank Lloyd Wright Trust and The Field Museum. Additional hands-on activities for students will also be provided and can take place before or after events, or in-classroom.



Overview: Assembly at School with minimum 250 students plus teachers/chaperones. Includes screening of (1) episode, interactive Q and A with Museum expert and hands-on demo/activity to engage students in science. Additional activity tables can be constructed for student use before or after event.

1-hour Event Schedule:

- 0:00 - 0:30 - Short intro and then screening of (1) one Episode
- 0:30 - 1:00 - Q and A by Expert, plus Activity or Demo led by Expert and DTF staff person
- Pre- and Post- Event (optional): 1-2 Moochie activity tables featuring additional hands-on activities and/or 1-2 Sponsor Activity tables for 30-minutes before and after event to engage kids in other activities. Depends on space and time availability of school. Moochie Kalala team will arrive 1-hour in advance for set-up

Event Dates, Episodes and Experts:

- Schools should supply (3) dates/times that work for hosting a Moochie Kalala event at their school.
- Episode, demos and activities will all correspond to the Museum attending the event. (i.e. if Shedd Aquarium, then Shedd Episode will be screened, and demonstrate will be an Echolocation activity).
- Museums/Experts will be determined based on availability that corresponds to the School.
- Schools can note preferences for Museums, but that is not guaranteed.

Schools Must Provide:

- Attendance by minimum 250 kids
- Auditorium or Gym with Screen/Projector
- 4-6 Teacher or Parent volunteers to help with set-up and/or activities
- 1 table near entrance for goody bags and supplies
- 1 table on-stage for demos (off to side until after screening)
- Additional tables for hands-on activities (if doing)
